



ORIGINAL GARMENT: To fit 40cm.

### MATERIALS:

1 Hank **EXPRESS YOURSELF INSPIRE** 100g

8mm Knitting needles  
5mm Crochet hook  
Stitch holder

### TENSION:

10sts x 15 rows worked over stocking stitch using 8mm knitting needles gives you a swatch of 10cm.

### MEASUREMENTS:

To fit an average adult.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**beg** – begin(ning)  
**dc** - double crochet  
**dec** – decrease  
**inc** – increase  
**k** – knit  
**p** – purl  
**rem** – remain(ing)  
**R(W)S** – right (wrong) side  
**st(s)** – stitch(es)  
**st st** – stocking stitch  
**tog** – together

### NOTE:

3ch (=tr).  
1ch (= not the first dc of each row unless stated otherwise).

### EARFLAPS PATTERN (KNIT TWO):

Cast on 1st.  
**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** Inc by working k1, p1, k1 in this st.  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Row:** P.  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** K, inc at beg and end of row.  
**4<sup>th</sup> Row:** P.  
**5<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> Row:** Rep 3<sup>rd</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> row.  
Do not cast off. Leave these sts on a stitch holder. Work another flap in the same way.

### PATTERN:

Using 8mm needles, cast on 5sts, k these sts and then k across 11sts of first earflap, turn work and cast on 10sts, turn work back to RS and work across the 11sts of the second earflap, turn work and cast on 5sts.  
Starting with WS, p row.  
Work 14 more rows in st st (= 10cm).  
Dec for crown.  
**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** K2, k2tog, (k3, k2tog) 6 times, k2.  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Row and every alt row:** P.  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** K2, k2tog, (k3, k2tog) 6 times, k1.  
**5<sup>th</sup> Row:** (K2, k2tog) to end of row.  
**7<sup>th</sup> Row:** K2, k2tog, (k1, k2tog) 5 times, k2.

**9<sup>th</sup> Row:** K1, (k2tog) to end of row.

**10<sup>th</sup> Row:** P1, (p2tog) to end of row.

Cut yarn leaving a tail of about 35cm.  
Thread yarn through rem sts and pull sts up tightly. Using the same thread, sew up the back seam.

Using a 5mm crochet hook work a row of dc around the edge of the beanie.  
Using two strands tog, crochet a chain to desired length or sew on a contrasting ribbon to each earflap.  
A pom-pom can be sewn onto the crown of the beanie if desired.
